

RED ANGUS SHOW CLASSIFICATIONS

- *Red Angus Show year runs from July 1 to June 30.*
- *It is recommended that any class with 10 or more head be split.*
- *All females show in their respected class, even if they have calved.*
- *Calves showing at side of dam, do not have to be registered if they are born after the entry deadline, unless they are shown in an individual class. However, they must be qualified to be registered.*
- *The only bulls shown in the National Junior Show will be in the Bred and Owned Bull Calf “Group Class”. No bulls will be shown in any other class.*

26	<i>Mature Cow & Calf</i>	Female Class	Cow must be born before January, two years prior to beginning of show year. Calf must be under 250 days of age and still nursing.
27	<i>Senior Champion</i>	Female Class	Winners from Class 24, 25 and 26.
28	<i>Reserve Senior Champion</i>	Female Class	Remaining Class winners and the 2 nd prize winner from the Class of the Senior Champion.
29	<i>Grand Champion</i>	Female Class	Class 4, 8, 12, 17, 22 and 27.
30	<i>Reserve Grand Champion</i>	Female Class	Remaining Class winners and the 2 nd place winner from the Class of the Senior Champion.

“GROUP” CLASSES – JUNIOR SHOW

Class	Title	Description
31	<i>Bred and Owned Female</i>	Junior Member must be the breeder and one of the owners of the heifer.
32	<i>Bred and Owned Bull Calf</i>	Junior Member must be the breeder and meet the ownership qualifications of the bull calf as outlined.
33	<i>Junior Showmanship</i>	Only open to JRA Members 15 years old and younger the day of the show and who entered and exhibited the animal they are showing in this competition (must be owned by the exhibitor as the rules state) in the Junior show that day.
34	<i>Senior Showmanship</i>	Only Open to JRA Members 16 years to 21 years of age the day of the show and who entered and exhibited the animal they are showing in this competition (must be owned by the exhibitor as the rules state) in the JR show that day.

65	<i>Produce-of-Dam</i>	Two animals by the same dam, either or both sexes, both shown in their respective classes. Animals shown in this class need not be owned by the exhibitor.
66	<i>Senior Get-of-Sire</i>	Four animals by the same sire, both sexes represented, need not be owned by the exhibitor. All animals must have been shown in their respective classes.
67	<i>Junior Get-of-Sire</i>	Three animals by the same sire, both sexes represented, need not be owned by the exhibitor. Entries must have been calved on or after September 1, year prior to beginning of show year. All animals must have been shown in their respective classes.
68	<i>Premier Breeders Class</i>	Will be computed from breeders' placement in individual classes only as follows: 3 points for each 1st; 2 points for each 2nd; 1 point for each 3rd. Maximum number of placements to be used to determine winner shall be limited to 5. Calculated on breeders of animals for exhibitors only. (In case of a tie, the next highest individual class placement will be used to determine the winner.)

101	<i>Senior Get-of-Sire</i>	Four animals by the same sire, both sexes represented, need not be owned by the exhibitor. All animals must have been shown in their respective classes.
102	<i>Junior Get-of-Sire</i>	Three animals by the same sire, both sexes represented, need not be owned by the exhibitor. Entries must have been calved on or after September 1, year prior to beginning of show year. All animals must have been shown in their respective classes.
103	<i>Premier Breeders Class</i>	Will be computed from breeders’ placement in individual classes only as follows: 3 points for each 1st; 2 points for each 2nd; 1 point for each 3rd. Maximum number of placements to be used to determine winner shall be limited to 5. Calculated on breeders of animals for exhibitors only. (In case of a tie, the next highest individual class placement will be used to determine the winner.)
